

3rd Amendment Workshop

BS7671:2008 Incorporating Amendment 3:2015

The publication of the latest version of BS7671 takes place on the 1st January 2015. This release will be the introduction of the third Amendment to the IET Wiring Regulations.

The enforcement of the content within this latest edition will be required for all electrical installation designs, construction and inspection and testing from the 1st July 2015. So you are given 6 months to revise the new regulations and make any necessary adjustments to your area of work and working methods.

Learners will gain a full understanding of the changes introduced to BS7671:2008.

What Does the Workshop Cover?
