The Government approved Document P (electrical safety) came into effect on the 1st January 2005. For the first time the mainstream work of domestic electrical installers became subject to the requirements and procedures associated with Building Control.

The City and Guilds 2393-10 course teaches those who are already working in the electrical industry but do not currently have any formal qualifications in Building Regulations.

Anyone who works in an environment that falls under the Building Regulations will need to complete this course.

Who is the Course Designed For?

It is most suitable for those who already work in the industry in domestic electrical environment and have several years experience.

What Does the Course Cover?

Covering all aspects of the general requirements of the Building Regulations in relation to electrical installations for dwellings.

- 2. Understand notifiable and non-notifiable types of building work,
- 3. Identify relevant approved documents,
- 4. Identify the role of Building Control Services.

This course teaches the methods of compliance for all seven parts of the Building Regulations most relevant to electrical installations in dwellings.

What Assessments Are There?

- · Basic Understanding of 3 Phase.
