- Ensuring safe systems and equipment before work
- Inspecting electrical installations before they are in operation
- Commissioning electrotechnical systems and equipment

Each topic covered in the programme aims to ensure a thorough understanding of the subject matter to allow learners to successfully carry out work using these new skills.


