Il electrical appliances in a commercial or public environment need to be PAT tested. Once this is completed it should be marked with a label to say that it has been tested and is safe to use.

This course focuses on the management of PAT testing jobs including record keeping, administration and legislation in PAT testing.

If you are responsible for the management of PAT testing this course will provide you with a vital qualification to enable you to carry out this role.
