A registration such as this will help identify you nationally as a competent Part P qualified Domestic Electrical Installer who holds the necessary Part P qualification.

Part P is vital for the understanding of the techniques and practice of electrical installation work and to enable you to become competent in its procedure.

Who is the Course Designed For?

All electrical work carried out in domestic properties must comply with Part P of the Building Regulations.

It is ideal for all those wanting to carry out electrical work that falls under Part P regulations and anyone wanting to enhance and improve their career to include more services.

It may be useful for those who have completed a plumbing course as an additional asset and for those who carry out domestic electrical work as part of their main business, i.e. kitchen fitters and joiners.

What Does the Course Cover?

Learners will cover the following units:

- Applicable Building Regulations for domestic electrical installation,
- · Electrical Safety Legislation, regulations, standards and terminology,
- Domestic electrical circuit installation,
- Installing domestic lighting circuits,
- · Domestic electrical earthing and bonding requirements,
- Inspection, testing and commissioning single phase domestic electrical circuits,
- Special locations and installations, including pre-work survey and inspection,
- Basic understanding of three phase.

All of the units must be understood and learnt by learners in order to progress to the examination section.

All of these exams must be passed in order to pass the course.
