Who is this course suitable for?

This course is suitable for electricians and electrical professionals who already hold the City & Guilds 2382-22 qualification. Learners do not need to have previously attended Amendment 2 or Amendment 3 update courses. If you do not hold the 2382-22 qualification, you should enrol on the full City & Guilds 2382-26 18th Edition Wiring Regulations Course instead.

What Does the Course Cover?

Rather than covering the full 18th Edition syllabus, this course focuses on the changes introduced in Amendment 4. Key updates include new requirements for stationary secondary batteries, Power over Ethernet (PoE), functional earthing and bonding for ICT equipment, and revisions to medical locations. The course covers changes to the following areas:

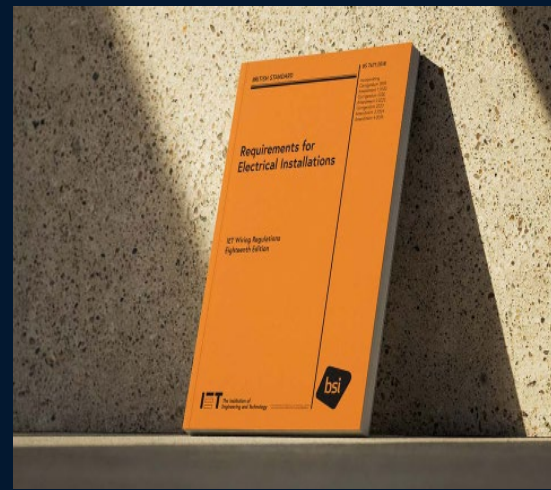
